Explanation of orthography:

ch=± (voiceless palatal (alveo-palatal?) affricate); y=j(palatal glide); j=@ (voiced palatal affricate); cApItAl vOwEls=[-ATR] vowels; other vowels have normal IPA(not English) values; th=theta (voiceless interdental fricative); dh=p(voiced interdental fricative); N=? (velar nasal); double vowel=long vowel; ny=... (palatal nasal); sh=• (voiceless palatal fricative);

Note:

I received an email from a visitor to my site who stated the following:

*We lived in South Nyanza Kenya for 15 years and speak dhoLuo fluently. I looked at your website for the first time today. I haven't read it all but I will say your indication of future tense, abondiko is a contraction of the verb "abiro" (I come, or I am coming (in English we'd say "going"), and the verbe ndiko. Another way of making the future is anandik (which is the proper way of making the future with the infix "na" and dropping the final "o". Just thought you'd like to know.*

**Nyasaye ogwedhi!**

I note the email mostly because it's impossible for me to verify or disprove the information, since I no longer have access to my informant for my data.
